THE DECEPTIVE TRINITY:

The Dragon (Satan) as God the Father:

Then another sign appeared in heaven: and behold, a great red dragon having seven heads and ten horns, and on his heads were seven diadems. And his tail swept away a third of the stars of heaven and threw them to the earth. And the dragon stood before the woman who was about to give birth, so that when she gave birth he might devour her child.

And the great dragon was thrown down, the serpent of old who is called the devil and Satan, who (what) deceives the whole world; he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him.

Revelation 12:3-4; 9

The Beast from the Sea (anti-Christ) as Jesus the Son:

And the dragon stood on the sand of the seashore. Then I saw a beast coming up out of the sea, having ten horns and seven heads, and on his horns were ten diadems, and on his heads were blasphemous names. And the beast which I saw was like a leopard, and his feet were like those of a bear, and his mouth like the mouth of a lion. And the dragon gave him (1) his power and (2) his throne and (3) great authority.

Revelation 13:1-2

The Beast from the Earth (false prophet) as the Holy Spirit:

Then I saw another beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a lamb and he spoke as a dragon. He exercises all the authority of the first beast in his presence. And he makes the earth and those who dwell in it to worship the first beast, whose fatal wound was healed. He performs great signs, so that he even makes fire come down out of heaven to the earth in the presence of men. And he deceives those who dwell on the earth because of the signs which it was given him to perform in the presence of the beast, telling those who dwell on the earth to make an image to the beast who had the wound of the sword and has come to life.

Revelation 13:11-14

And I saw coming out of the mouth of the (1) dragon and out of the mouth of the (2) beast and out of the mouth of the (3) false prophet, three unclean spirits like frogs.

Revelation 16:13

And the beast was seized, and with him the false prophet who performed the signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who had received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image; these two were thrown alive into the lake of fire which burns with brimstone.

Revelation 19:20

And the (1) devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the (2) beast and the (3) false prophet are also; and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

Revelation 20:10

THE NATURE OF SATANTIC DECEPTION:

His description:

From the lips of Jesus:

"You are of your father the devil, and you want to do the desires of your father. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth (why) because there is no truth in him. Whenever he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own nature, for he is a liar and the father of lies."

John 8:44

"Beware of the (who) false prophets, who come to you (how) in sheep's clothing, but inwardly are ravenous wolves. You will know them by their fruits. Grapes are not gathered from thorn bushes nor figs from thistles, are they? So every good tree bears good fruit, but the bad tree bears bad fruit. A good tree cannot produce bad fruit, nor can a bad tree produce good fruit. Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. So then, you will know them by their fruits."

Matthew 7:15-20

"Many false prophets will arise and will mislead many."

Matthew 24:11

"And then if anyone says to you, 'Behold, here is the Christ'; or, 'Behold, He is there'; do not believe him; for false Christs and false prophets will arise, and will show signs and wonders, in order to lead astray, if possible, the elect. But take heed; behold, I have told you everything in advance."

Mark 13:21-23

From the pen of Paul:

For such men are false apostles, deceitful workers, disguising themselves as apostles of Christ. No wonder, for even Satan disguises himself as an angel of light. Therefore it is not surprising if his servants also disguise themselves as servants of righteousness, whose end will be according to their deeds.

2 Corinthians 11:13-15

But the Spirit explicitly says that (when) in later times some will fall away from the faith, paying attention to (1) deceitful spirits and (2) doctrines of demons.

1 Timothy 4:1

And even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, in whose case the god of this world has (what) blinded the minds of (who) the unbelieving (why) so that they might not see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.

2 Corinthians 4:3-4

The words of Peter:

But false prophets also arose among the people, just as there will also be false teachers among you, who will (what) secretly introduce destructive heresies, even denying the Master who bought them, bringing swift destruction upon themselves. Many will follow their sensuality, and because of them the way of the truth will be maligned; and in their greed they will exploit you with false words; their judgment from long ago is not idle, and their destruction is not asleep. 2 Peter 2:1-3

Finally, from John:

Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God, (why) because many false prophets have gone out into the world.

1 John 4:1

Warnings from the Old Testament:

From Moses:

"If a prophet or a dreamer of dreams arises among you and gives you (what) a sign or a wonder, and (what) the sign or the wonder comes true, concerning which he spoke to you, saying, 'Let us go after other gods whom you have not known and let us serve them,' you shall not listen to the words of that prophet or that dreamer of dreams; (why) for the Lord your God is testing you to find out if you love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul. You shall follow the Lord your God and fear Him; and you shall keep His commandments, listen to His voice, serve Him, and cling to Him. But that prophet or that dreamer of dreams shall be put to death, because he has counseled rebellion against the Lord your God who brought you from the land of Egypt and redeemed you from the house of slavery, to seduce you from the way in which the Lord your God commanded you to walk. So you shall purge the evil from among you."

"For thus says the Lord of hosts, the God of Israel, 'Do not let (1) your prophets who are in your midst and (2) your diviners (what) deceive you, and do not listen to the dreams which they dream. For they prophesy falsely to you in My name; (how) I have not sent them,' declares the Lord."
